**MANSTON AIRPORT 106 CONSULTATION**

Monkton Parish Council ask that the following points are taken into consideration as part of the Consultation process:

- there is very strong opposition to the principle of night flights in this Parish
- it is considered there is a complete lack of adequate noise monitoring facilities, an issue that should be addressed within a specified time frame in the new Agreement
- an Environmental Assessment should be undertaken as a matter of priority
- there are clear weaknesses in the existing 106 Agreement – this is of major concern, as it would appear the new Agreement is principally to be based on the existing one
- Parishioners are deeply concerned about planes deviating from specified flight routes over village – this has a significant impact for villagers, and has been an on-going noise problem from the outset despite numerous complaints from both Villagers, MACC and others
- MORI questionnaires were not distributed to households in this Village
- Villagers who have used the complaints system have found it to be woefully inadequate; complaints are rarely upheld, and replies disparaging

It is hoped TDC will ensure Manston can develop within a carefully monitored and controlled framework which will protect the environmental interests of the local community and the economic success of Manston at the same time.

The above issues are of great concern to this Parish. Monkton Parish Council requests in the strongest possible terms that these issues are addressed and resolved in the new Agreement.
